

Tri-Boro Trailer Do's & Don'ts

Do's

1. Change the A/C filters monthly
2. Ensure you have the correct power requirements for the trailer you are renting.
3. Use a certified electrician to provide power to the trailer.
4. Provide a level and obstacle free site.
5. Provide as much lead time as possible for trailer delivery or pickup however expedited service is available at an additional cost.
6. Make sure that the trailer is unhooked from all utilities and accessible prior to pick up.
7. Indicate Tri-Boro Trailer as an additional named insured with your insurance carrier on all equipment rented.
8. Avoid common damage charges: Remove signs. Avoid using tape on the paneling. Replace A/C filters. Return keys.
9. Refer to the service guide.

Don't

1. Haul the trailer yourself.
2. Move the trailer onsite with equipment. Customer is responsible for all damages.
3. Modify the floor plan or remove installed furniture without prior approval from the Tri-Boro Trailer office.
4. Remove the stay chain from the exterior door. Customer is responsible for damage to the door.
